#### FIREARMS LICENCE APPLICATIONS

If you use the Australian Deer Association Inc. as your approved club for Genuine Need for possession, then you need to quote our Club Approval Number which is 407832036. All members using club membership are required by law to attend a minimum of two events each year to meet their qualification requirements.

The Victorian Government is opening their border for interstate travel from the 1st June and has allowed camping to take place. This will allow people to go to Victoria and hunt. There will most likely be many Victorians hunting at the same time and it may be best if only hunters experienced in hunting in Victoria go down on the long weekend.

The Branch Hunt to the Wonnangatta/Moroka Junction is still cancelled. There are no Branch Executive members available to take on the role of Hunt Master to ensure that the hunt is conducted in accordance with ADA Policy.

For anyone going on a hunt do continue to take the precautions to prevent catching the Covid-19 virus or passing it on. If you have any flu like symptoms stay home, get yourself tested and if needed self-isolate. While travelling continue with the 1.5m spacing in shops and elsewhere. In camp and around the campfire maintain the 4 m<sup>2</sup> spacing.

# **Firearms Amendment (COVID-19) Regulation**

2020 under the Firearms Act 1996

### Schedule 2 COVID-19 pandemic—special provisions 7 Participation requirements for club members—Part 10 compliance periods

- (1) A compliance period (within the meaning of Part 10 of this Regulation) that includes the day on which the *Firearms Amendment (COVID-19) Regulation 2020* commenced is extended by 12 months in addition to the 12-month period determined under clause 105 of this Regulation.
- (2) To avoid doubt, the extension of the compliance period has the effect that a new compliance period does not start until the end of the extension.

#### 12 Minor's firearms permit—continuation of authority past 18th birthday

If the relevant conditions apply, the period of 3 months prescribed in clause 54 of this Regulation is taken to be a period of 12 months.

### The President's Message Sydney & Western Sydney

This newsletter contains extracts for recent legislation dealing with Covid-19 and the Firearms Act. Essentially it means that the requirement for those members claiming membership of ADA as part of their "genuine reason" do not have to attend two approved events this year.

We will not be holding the June meeting. The limits on how many can be in a club and the social distancing requirements would mean that not all members would be allowed to come into the meeting room.

When we do hold the meetings, a decision will have to be made relating to the location for Sydney Branch meetings and the continuation of Western Sydney Sub-Branch. There is a desire to move the Sydney meetings to the Emu Club and then close the Western Sydney Sub-Branch. The reason being that not enough members are attending the meetings at the Mounties Club in Fairfield.

Due to the Coronavirus outbreak and the Prime Minister's and the State Premier's new rules all meetings from Sydney and Western Sydney branch are cancelled until further notice. The committee will be working together to keep the Branch running.

There are cancellations and postponements of events. Already the SSAA SHOT EXPO for June has been postponed. I would expect that the August Gun Show at the Sydney International Shooting Centre will be postponed or cancelled. The Deer Hunter Education Course set down for August has been cancelled.

There has at least been some good news in that the Game Licencing Unit has reopened the State Forests for hunting. There was a rush of applications when hunting was allowed. It would be wise to book in as early as you can to be able to get into the forests that you want to hunt in.

All members who have an email address will be aware of the change of administration for NSW. For the benefit of those who do not have email, the message was that at the March State Conference the Branches chose not to have a State Executive, but would instead have State Co-ordinator to liaise between the ADA Board and the Branches. The default position is direct administration by the Board. The message included a request for any member interested in taking on the State-Coordinators to get in touch with your Branch President or Doug Young
